

HPAC Prerequisites

1. All campers must be entering grades 6-9.
2. To sign up for musical theater, you just need to have a desire to act, sing, and dance... no experience necessary!
3. To sign up for band, you must have previously been playing a concert band instrument for at least one year (*flute, oboe, clarinet, bass clarinet, saxophone, trumpet, French horn, trombone, baritone, tuba, percussion*).
4. To sign up for band, you must bring your own instrument to camp (*if you have been borrowing one from the Hartford School District, you may continue to do so*).
5. Campers should come to camp equipped with: sneakers, water, instrument, lunch, and comfortable clothing. We do play games outside for the HPAC Olympics!

FYI: Due to the nature of our performance-driven rehearsals, campers should not miss any part of the camp day.
